Question Number 3: Is this an international tender, or no?

Answer: This is not an international Tender, and it is Only for Eligible companies in Mozambique

Question Number 4: For the samples on timber, roof sheet and steel rods do we have to send a whole length, or we can send cut pieces?

Answer: Yes, the wood timber samples should be in full length, while for the metal sheet, it is acceptable to be cut into pieces. This should align with the technical specifications. Furthermore, the service provider is expected to label all the samples provided.

Question Number 5: The wood timber (rafter and purlin) should be treated or not?

Answer: No, it shouldn't, and vendor can also quote for the treated material separately

Question Number 6: The vendor asked about the delivery locations?

Answer: The service provider should deliver the material to IOM Warehouse in Beira

Question Number 7: For the construction Bucket, is it a mandatory to have the bucket with pouring lip or no?

Answer: Yes, it is mandatory to have this pouring lip.
