IOM is dedicated to promoting humane and orderly migration for the benefit of all. It does so by providing services and advice to governments and migrants.

IOM is committed to a diverse and inclusive environment. For the purpose of this vacancy, the following internal candidates who meet the eligibility criteria are considered as first-tier candidates:

- Internal candidates in Professional and Highter Categories and National Officer (NO) Category with regular or fixed-term contracts should meet the minimum time in post requirement of 12 months, for Special Short-Term contract holders, the minimum time in post is 6 months at the time, of the closing of the VN.
- There is no time in post requirement for staff members in the General Service (GS) category.

In addition, all applicants should meet eligibility requirements for languages, education and work experience requirements stipulated in the SVN.

Context:

The International Organization for Migration (IOM), the UN Migration Agency is a dynamic and growing inter-governmental organization, with 174 member states. IOM is committed to the principle that "humane and orderly migration benefits migrants and society". Established in 1951 and now active in over 590 field locations worldwide, IOM works with partners, government, and civil society to promote international cooperation to address operational challenges of migration and mobility, assist in the search for practical solutions to migration problems, and to provide humanitarian assistance to migrants in need, including refugees and

internally displaced people. IOM addresses the migratory phenomenon from an integral and holistic perspective, including links to development, to maximize its benefits and minimize its negative effects.

Within its Migration Health Division (MHD), IOM delivers and promotes comprehensive, preventive, and curative health programmes which are beneficial, accessible, and equitable for migrants and mobile populations. Bridging the needs of both migrants and IOM's Member States, MHD contributes towards the physical, mental, and social well-being of migrants, enabling them and host communities to achieve social and economic development.

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- 1) Provide support to organize and implement IOM's migration health portfolio (HIV/TB, Cholera response, emergency health and nutrition activities) in Northern Mozambique.
- 2) Assist in the coordination and liaison with district health authorities, as well as humanitarian and development partners, including participation in local meetings, documenting meeting and following-up on outcomes.
- 3) Assist in the follow-up, access to care and referral of patients identified through the displacement cycle ensuring they are not lost to care but rather are linked to care at each step of the cycle.
- 4) Work with the integrated health-MHPSS-protection field teams in implementing activities including health education, community engagement, identification of lost-to-follow-up and other vulnerable patients, active case finding and screening, and referrals.
- 5) Organize integrated mobile brigades in coordination with district health authorities to deliver primary health care services to displaced populations and host communities, and as needed, support liaison with health authorities and proper escorts.
- 6) Provide supervision of team leaders from integrated field teams and ensure regular monitoring and reporting of community-based activities and primary health care service delivery; including follow up with team leaders on weekly community-based reports and preparing reports on service delivery by integrated mobile brigades, for updating of health programme databases.
- 7) Work closely with MHPSS, Protection and CCCM teams towards the delivery of integrated services to beneficiaries and cross-referrals.
- 8) Work closely with MHPSS, Protection and CCCM teams towards the delivery of integrated services to beneficiaries and cross-referrals.
- 9) Perform other duties as may be assigned.

Required Qualifications and Experience

Education

- Bachelor's degree in Medicine, Nursing, Public Health, epidemiology or other related area with at least three (3) years of relevant experience or
- High school diploma with at least five (5) years of relevant experience.

Experience

- Professional experience implementing and monitoring health projects and interventions, including Nutrition, HIV/AIDS, TB.
- Previous experience in health programming in emergency is an advantage.
- Experience in project implementation and monitoring of activities at field level.
- Previous experience with IOM a distinct advantage.
- Experience in community outreach, social activism.
- Experience working in coordination with local health authorities and partners, including working with decentralized health care system at the community and district levels.

Skills

- Strong writing skills.
- Knowledge of emergency health, and/or primary health care.
- Ability to document, organize, store, and disseminate project information to facilitate knowledge management.
- Capacity to write succinct activity and quarterly reports.
- Strong presentation skills to aptly participate in different forums such as meetings and conferences.
- Excellent communication and analytical skills.
- Ability to work with a high degree of independence within assigned areas.
- Good teamwork skills especially with community health workers.
- Good communication skills, personal commitment, efficiency, and flexibility.
- Knowledge of the health and social protection system (advantageous).
- Ability to work effectively and harmoniously in a multicultural environment.
- Good computer literacy, especially MS Excel.
- Demonstrated ability to deliver quality assignments under tight timeframes.
- Ability to work independently, to follow leads.
