- Internal candidates in Professional and Highter Categories and National Officer (NO) Category with regular or fixed-term contracts should meet the minimum time in post requirement of 12 months, for Special Short-Term contract holders, the minimum time in post is 6 months at the time, of the closing of the VN.
- There is no time in post requirement for staff members in the General Service (GS) category.

In addition, all applicants should meet eligibility requirements for languages, education and work experience requirements stipulated in the SVN.

Context:

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

- 1. Support the design and implementation of the Health Program MEAL and information management plan for effective integration and sharing of data and information for planning, monitoring, and reporting; including working with partners to share and compare data.
- 2. Assist in the development of the health programme MEAL annual workplans in coordination with the programme team.
- 3. Support the development of reports for donors, government, other UN agencies and other stakeholders.
- 4. Provide inputs on the use of artificial intelligence and algorithms for improving the efficiency of data management and analysis.
- 5. Provide inputs on the use of effective internet-based systems that can be used to upload and share data, maps, graphics building upon existing systems in IOM.
- 6. Support the creation of questionnaires and surveys in both Portuguese and English to measure the quality of IOM activities.
- 7. Assist programme teams to develop monitoring tools, including post-distribution monitoring, satisfaction surveys, pre and post evaluations, mid-term project evaluations/reviews. and others.
- 8. Support the implementation of internal assessments and management of external evaluations, including but not limited to, the revision of TORs, support to evaluate teams during visits and field work, data gathering and analysis, and reporting.
- 9. Assist in the implementation of accountability mechanisms within the Health Program based on the guidelines established within the MEAL system.
- 10. Assist in the implementation of learning components and events using data gathered, lessons learned and best practices.
- 11. Provide inputs on how data can be displayed in the most effective ways using specific design programs.
- 12. Develop and implement comprehensive fundraising strategies and plans to diversify funding streams and achieve fundraising goals.
- 13. Any other such duties requested by the supervisor.

Education

 Communications, Geodetics, International Relations, Political Science, Social Sciences or any related discipline from an accredited academic institution with at least three years of relevant working experience. or
- Minimum completed High School degree with certification in computer science with at least five years of relevant work experience.

- Experience in communicating and working with a wide range of people, including people of culturally diverse backgrounds.
- Previous working experience in an international organization and familiarity with the IOM/UN common system or similar systems is an advantage Demonstrated experience in delivering training and capacity-building initiatives.

Skills

- Solid computer skills, including proficiency in MS Office package (Office, Excel, Power Point, Outlook), is essential.
- Undertake duties delegated by the respective supervision, hold self-accountable in completion of assigned task and manage resources efficiently.
- Knowledge of Computerized-aided design and data analysis programs, as well as design programs such as Adobe InDesign and photoshop is a strong advantage.
- Knowledge of Health Programming is an advantage.
